4. EXECUTING AGENCY

5. FINANCIAL ARRANGEMENT

- a) Any cooperation under this MOU is subject to the availability of funding sources and approval by relevant authorities.
- b) Any specific project of joint interest will be detailed in a separate agreement, including financial and program specific arrangements.

6. INTELLECTUAL PROPERTY RIGHTS

- a) Each Party shall protect, within its capacity and territory, intellectual property rights of the other Party in accordance with the laws and regulations in force in the state of Assam and the country of India.
- b) In case of specific arrangement, programs or projects that may result in intellectual property, the Parties shall conclude separate arrangement in accordance with the prevalent laws and regulations in the state of Assam and the country of India.

7. CONFIDENTIALITY :

In the event that either Party wishes to disclose any data and/or information supplied in or resulted from the implementation of this MOU, the disclosing Party shall have prior written consent of the other Party.

8. LIMITATION OF PERSONAL ACTIVITIES :

The Parties shall ensure that their personnel engaged in the activities under this MOU shall engage only in the activities under the framework of this MOU with respect to laws and regulations in the state of Assam and the country of India.

9. SETTLEMENT OF DISPUTES :

Any dispute concerning the implementation and/or application of this MOU shall be settled amicably through consultation or negotiation between the Parties.

10. AMENDMENT :

- a) This MOU may be amended or revised at any time by mutual written consent of the Parties and such amendment shall form and integral part of this MOU.
- b) Such amendment or revision shall come into force on the date as may be determined by the Parties.

- d) The termination of this MOU shall not affect the completion of any programs or projects in progress and not completed at the time of termination.





Guidelines: Both the colleges are affiliated to Assam University. They have the mandate to cater to the education aspiration of the people of respective areas. Therefore, both the parties hereto, have decided for collaboration as in the above mentioned areas in sharing of resources generated for teaching learning and Co-curricular activities for mutual benefit of the learners as per the following mutually agreed guidelines:

(I) The MoU will be valid for a period of 5 years before renewal.

(II) The Authorized signatories of both SRC and Nilambazar College shall manage this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and all endeavors that derive from it. (III) SRC and Nilambazar College shall hereby appoint in their respective colleges who shall be responsible for coordinating all communication and directions for the implementation and execution of the MoU.

(IV) Sharing of expenditure shall be determined by the parties on a project-by-project basis and will be incorporated by reference as an addendum to this MoU or additional implementation plans.

(V) Either party may terminate this MoU by written notification signed by the appropriate authority of the institution initiating the notice. However, the other party must receive such notification at least three months prior to the effective date of termination. In the event of disagreement on any of the terms and conditions of this MoU, the expenditure incurred by the parties would remain on 'As is Where is condition'. This would be decided on a project-by-project basis. In case of termination of agreement it shall be binding on both the parties to protect the interest of the students already enrolled in the programme. The students taking courses as part of an exchange at the partner institution should be allowed to continue till they complete the semester/ programme or till the students complete the permissible duration of the programme whichever is earlier.

(VI) The parties shall ensure that no information of document received from each other is made public without the formal approval of the partner.

(VIII) Any dispute arising out of this agreement shall be resolved through mutual consultation between both parties. In case of failure to resolve the dispute through negotiation third party arbitration may be adopted on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

If this is not possible due to irreconcilable differences, this MoU may be terminated by mutual consent of both parties. xii. SRC and GMCB will also share best and innovative practices and will work for Promotion of Skill Development Programmes to boost employment opportunities for the students and locality.

xiii. SRC and GMCB will work with Joint collaboration for promotion of OER and MOOCs.

The above areas of collaboration are not exhaustive and new areas may be proposed by their institution and agreed upon mutually.


Guidelines: Both the colleges are affiliated to Assam University. They have the mandate to cater to the education aspiration of the people of respective areas. Therefore, both the parties hereto, have decided for collaboration as in the above mentioned areas in sharing of resources generated for teaching learning and Co-curricular activities for mutual benefit of the learners as per the following mutually agreed guidelines:

(I) The MoU will be valid for a period of 5 years before renewal.

(II) The Authorized signatories of both SRC and GMCB shall manage this Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and all endeavors that derive from it. They (or their designated representatives) will be responsible for developing and carrying out a joint plan and submissions regular reports on the implementation of this MoU. Any activity proposed that does not fit into the general terms of this MoU will be formally

incorporated as an addendum to the implementation plan to this MoU, provided the addendum of implementation plan is agreed to and signed by both parties.

(II) For the purpose of facilitating the day-to-day implementation of this MoU, SRC and GMCB agree to have regular communication and correspondence. This MoU shall be effective and shall come into force upon signature of the authorized signatories of both the parties. It shall be subject to revision by written agreement between the two parties. All the parties shall keep the respective communities informed of this MoU to draw benefits from it and to contribute towards its implementation in spirit and substance.

(III) SRC and GMCB shall hereby appoint in their respective colleges who shall be responsible for coordinating all communication and directions for the implementation and execution of the MoU.

(IV) Sharing of expenditure shall be determined by the parties on a project-by-project basis and will be incorporated by reference as an addendum to this MoU or additional implementation plans.

(V) Either party may terminate this MoU by written notification signed by the appropriate authority of the institution initiating the notice. However, the other party must receive such notification at least three

months prior to the effective date of termination. In the event of disagreement on any of the terms and conditions of this MoU, the expenditure incurred by the parties would remain on 'As is Where is condition'. This would be decided on a project-by-project basis. In case of termination of agreement it shall be binding on both the parties to protect the interest of the students already enrolled in the programme. The students taking courses as part of an exchange at the partner institution should be allowed to continue till they complete the semester/ programme or till the students complete the permissible duration of the programme whichever is earlier.

(VI) The parties shall ensure that no information of document received from each other is made public without the formal approval of the partner.

(VII) Neither of the parties hereto shall be liable for non-performance or delay in performance for causes due to Force Majeure. For the purpose of this MoU, Force Majeure is defined as cause beyond the control of the party affected including natural calamities, acts of terrorism, war and civil commotion etc.

(VIII) Any dispute arising out of this agreement shall be resolved through mutual consultation between both parties. In case of failure to

resolve the dispute through negotiation third party arbitration may be adopted on mutually agreed terms and conditions.

(IX) The Parties undertake to work closely and cooperate in the implementation of this MoU and to endeavor to resolve disputes arising between them regarding this MoU in an amicable manner. If this is not possible due to irreconcilable differences, this MoU may be terminated by mutual consent of both parties. The parties to this Memorandum of Understanding or their authorized representatives acknowledge that they have read and understand this Memorandum of Understanding and agree to be bound by its terms.

(X) Intellectual Property developed by the joint efforts would be the joint property of the Parties. Any financial benefits or otherwise arising thereon would be shared proportionately by the parties in consonance with the efforts / inputs given by them.




