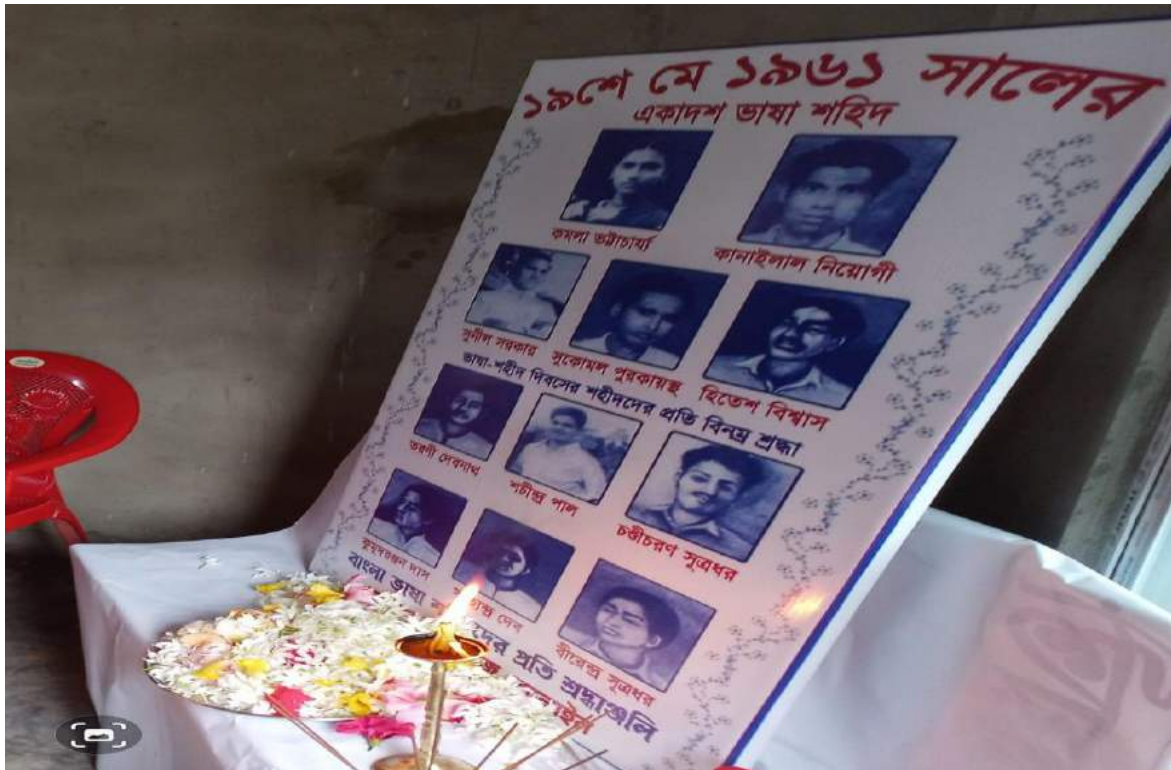

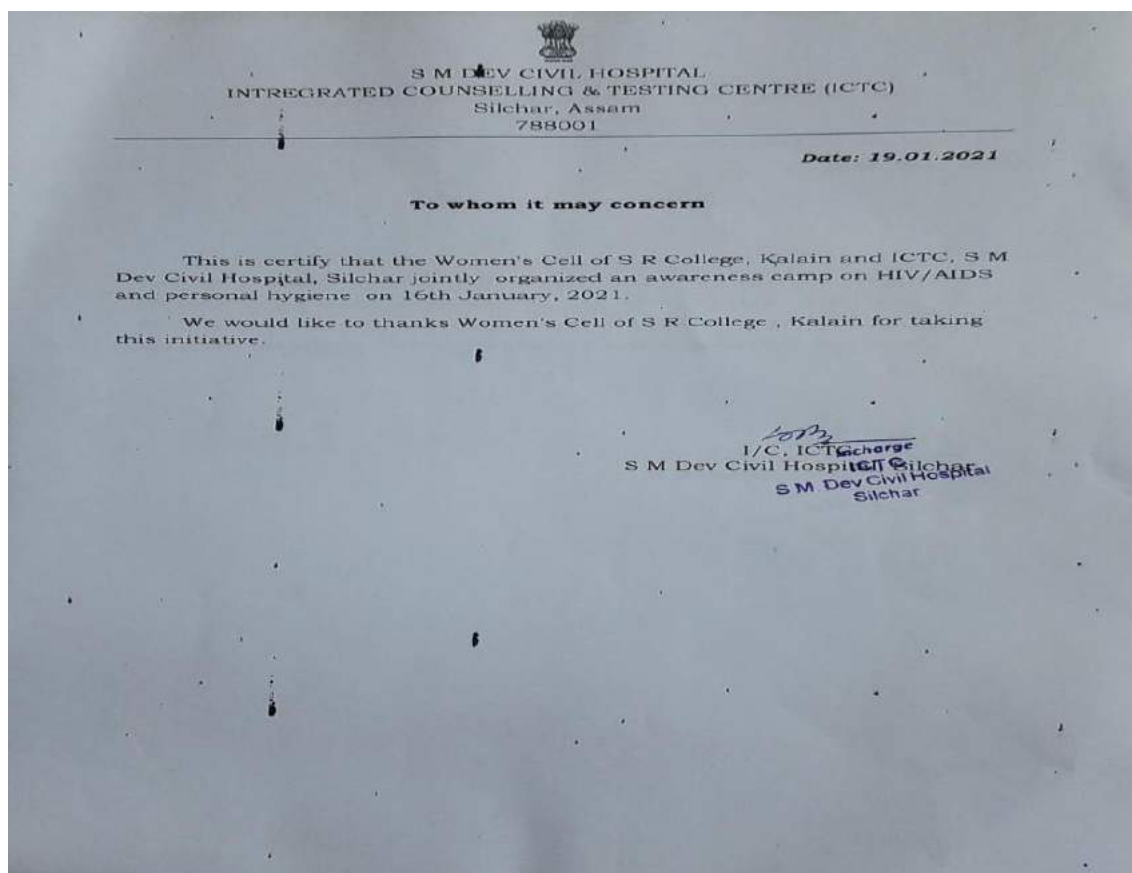

SOCIO-ECONOMIC VARIATIONS:

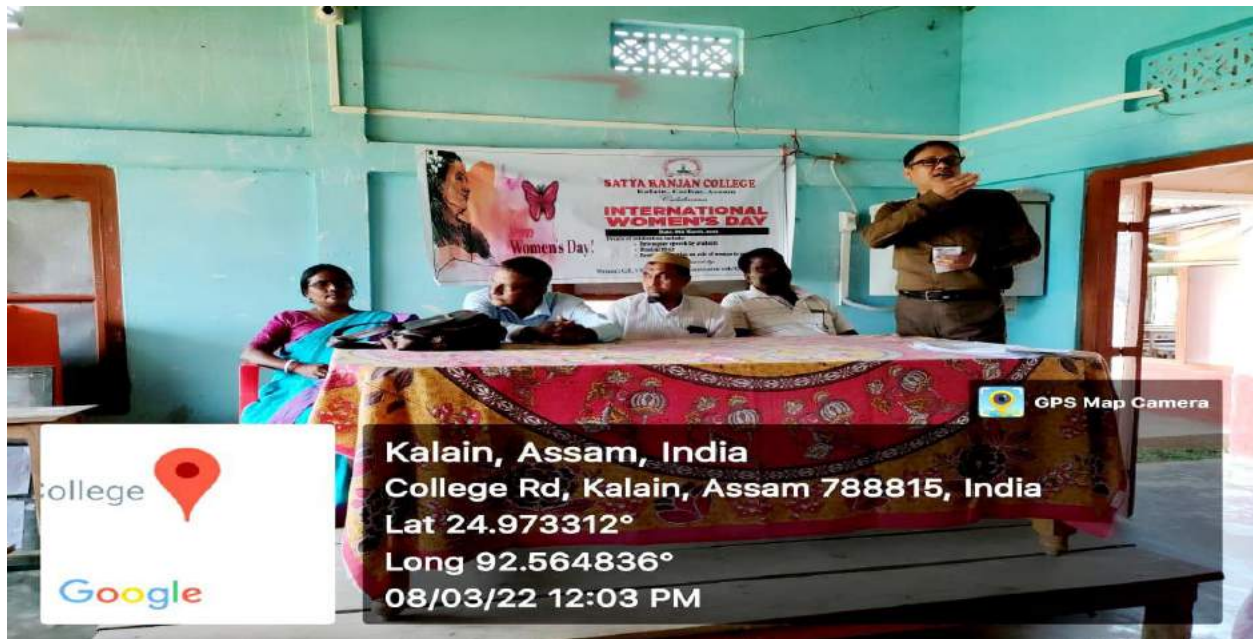
