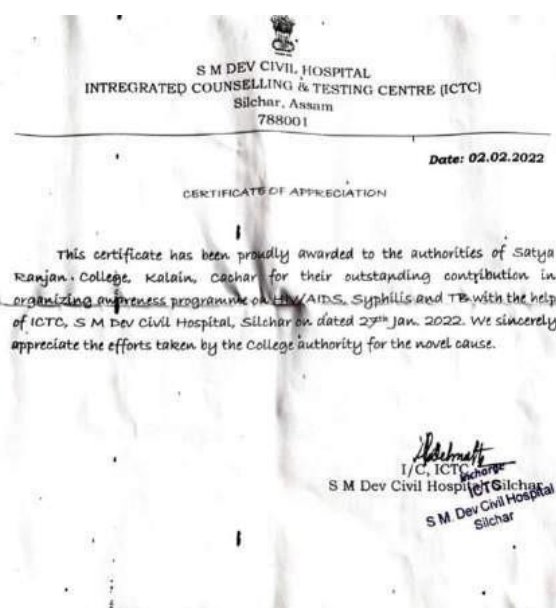


Extension Activities conducted by NCC Unit, Satya Ranjan College

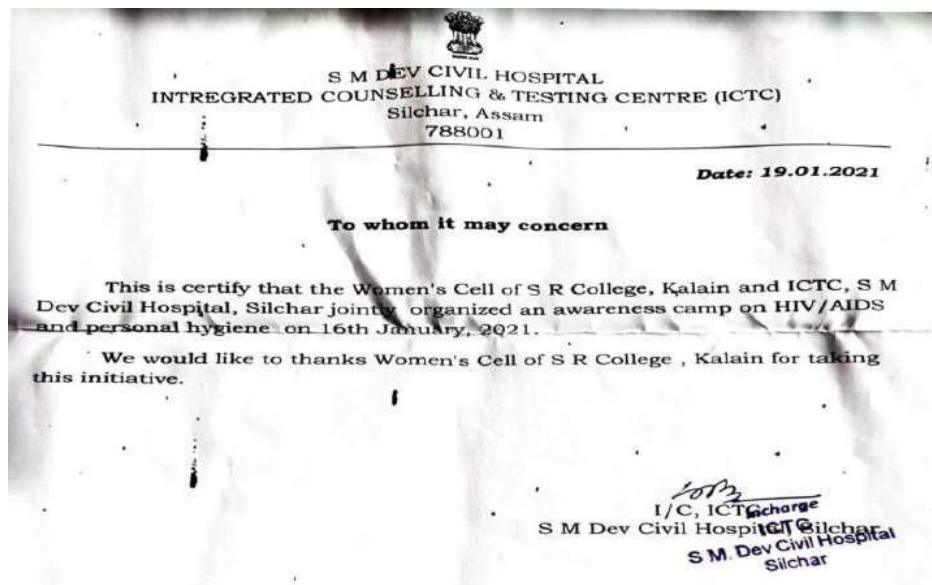
33) International Women's Day is celebrated by Satya Ranjan College on 8th March every year (2017-22) Gender related Legal awareness program.

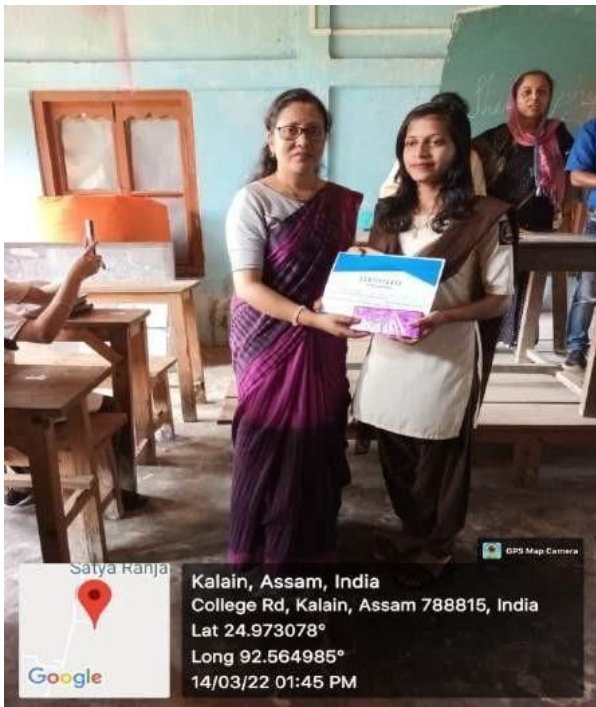
34) Gender sensitisation awareness program was held on 20th Aug 2018 to develop more awareness amongst the women of village areas about gender sensitisation

Extension Activities of Department of History

56) Historical field visit of Badarpur Fort (Karimganj) conducted by the Department of History in collaboration with IQAC of Satya Ranjan College, Kalain, Cachar on 5th February, 2022. Badarpur Fort is an important tourist destination which is located in the Karimganj District of Assam. It was built during the Mughal era and was a part of the present-day Karimganj district of Assam. It is situated along the banks of Barak River and extensive restoration work is going on to attract more tourists. It is spread over a vast area and entry through the main entrance, which is still standing tall, takes you inside the fort, most of which is in ruins. The view of the Barak River from this place is beautiful. The trip had started with two teachers and ten students from Satya Ranjan College, Kalain by hired car at around 10 AM in the morning. They reached the Fort at around 11 AM. The students and teachers visited there to see the beauty of the fort as well as the natural beauty of the area. The teachers explained the importance of historical places and forts.

The objectives of the visit are-

- a) To help the students engage in thoughtful interpretation of diverse understanding and sensitivity about the historical, economic, social, and cultural facts.

b) To provide first-hand experience of the past and inspire students to learn more about the glorious heritage of Barak valley.

c. To increase the significance of the site and to analyze the history of the place by viewing its historical monuments.

57) Educational Tour of Day-1 (Assam University) 20-10-2017

Day 1, Six faculty members with forty students have started their journey by bus at around 8 AM in the morning. After that they have done their breakfast in road side Dhaba and started again at 830 AM. The 2 hired buses with students and faculties reached Assam University at around 10-30 AM. The students visited different departments, Central Library, Hostels, Administrative building, Sahid Minnar and natural beauty of the campus. The aim of the tour is to develop interest to pursue higher education and to gather more knowledge in practical field. After that they returned home at around 5 PM.



58) Educational Tour of Day-2 (Cachari Fort, Khaspur) 21-10-2017

In day 2, like previous day, again six faculty members with forty students have started their journey by bus at around 8 AM in the morning. After having breakfast, again students and teachers have started their journey towards Cachari Fort, Khaspur at around 830 AM. The buses reached Khaspur at around 12 PM. Khaspur is located only 20 km from Silchar, in Cachar district of Assam. It houses the ruins of the Dimasa Kingdom, which are a magnificent sight to see. There is a king's temple, a Lion Gate, and a Sun Gate and these are centuries old. The king's palace is almost non-existence but the main entrance gates still stand tall. These gates are in elephant pattern. Originally a part of the Tripura Kingdom, Khaspur was ruled by a tributary ruler. It became independent after the fall of Koch power. As the last of the Koch ruler died, the control of Khaspur went into the hands of Kachari rulers and they shifted their capital to Khaspur.

Report of Rajasthan Tour (Session 2018-2019)



59. Educational tour is nothing but the planned combination of tours, site visits with the target of global learning which can enhance the knowledge of students and can help them to see the clear picture of the theoretical things they have learnt so far. As per the guidelines given by the Govt of Assam, all Higher educational institutions of Assam have to visit in Rajasthan for 2 days so that students can learn and gather practical knowledge by visiting the 'pink city'.

For smooth functioning of educational tour, the Govt of Assam has disbursed grant of Rs 1 lac to every higher educational institution. As far as the benefits of this tour are concerned, during such tours, students can actually see and enrich their knowledge of places and people they have learned about in the classroom. They can gain a deeper understanding of real life situations and trends than a book can ever convey. Along with this, students can get the chance to try out the languages they've studied with native speakers. They can build independence and confidence as they explore new places and

local customs. Perhaps most important of all, students gain new insights into their own culture, and a more global perspective.

In the session 2018-2019, with the instruction of Govt of Assam and prior permission of the college administration, Satya Ranjan College, Kalain has planned an educational tour from Kalain to Jaipur from 29/03/2019 to 06/04/2019. In this Tour, 11 students and 02 teachers have participated. All the participants along with 2 teachers gathered at Badarpur Railway Station at 7 pm on 29/03/2019. The journey started with Train No- 12516-Coimbatore Express at 7-00 pm. All the participants reached Guwahati at 6.30 am on next day that is on 30/03/2019. All the participants again headed their journey towards Jaipur by train from Guwahati to Jaipur with train no- 15632, Ghy Bme Mkn Express at 10-45 Am. The approximate distance is 1964-6 Km which has taken approximately 39 Hrs to reach the destination Jaipur at around 2 Am on 31-03-2019. The stay was arranged in Om Guest house, Gopalbari, Jaipur which is situated near Jaipur Railway Station.

On the next day, on 01-04-2019, after breakfast, participants have started our 1st day tour by hired cars and visited to Hawa Mahal, Jol Mahal and Amber Fort. The Hawa Mahal is dedicated to Lord Krishna. It is said that the shape of the building resembles the crown of Krishna. More than a palace, the Hawa Mahal is also a cultural and architectural marvel that reflects a truly harmonious amalgamation of the Hindu Rajput and Islamic Mughal architectural styles. In keeping with the visual language of the “Pink City” of Jaipur, the Hawa Mahal is built entirely in red sandstone which in the sunlight glows with a pink hue.

Jol Mahal is a splendid Palace Nestled in the Middle of a Lake, set in the middle of Man Sagar Lake, Jal Mahal (Water Palace) in Jaipur is a spectacular structure that seems to be floating on the lake's surface. Amer Fort or Amber Fort is a fort located in Amer, Rajasthan. Amer is a town which is located 11 kilometers from the Jaipur City which is the capital of Rajasthan. The fort is located high on a hill, it is the principal tourist attraction in Jaipur.

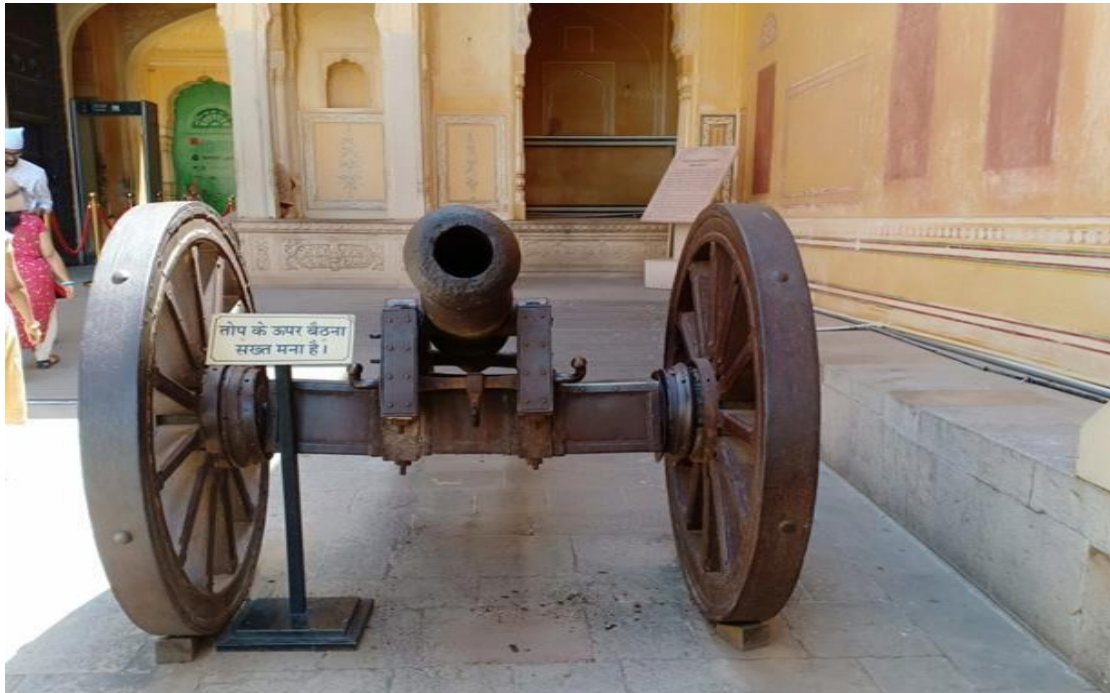


Rajasthan Tour (Session 2018-2019)

On day 2, that is on 02-04-2019, after breakfast, all the students along with 2 teachers have started journey to visit other places in Jaipur like Jaipur Museum, Jantar Mantar, and City Palace. After that, all participants have visited in different shops for purchasing traditional attire of Rajasthan.

The City Palace, Jaipur, which includes the Chandra Mahal and Mubarak Mahal palaces and other buildings, is a palace complex in Jaipur, the capital of the Rajasthan state, India. It was the seat of the Maharaja of Jaipur, the head of the Kachwaha Rajput clan. The Chandra Mahal palace now houses a museum, but the greatest part of it is still a royal residence.





On 03/04/2019 all the participants have started their return journey, at 10.00 pm, by train no.12970 Jaipur Coimbatore express, and reached kanpur on 04/0142019 around 12 PM at night. After that around 5-20 in the morning of the next day, we have started our return journey in poorvottar Sampark kranti Express (Train No-14038) from Kanpur to Badarpur and reached Badarpur at around 4-40 PM on next day that is on 05-04-2019.
