8. 4. (a) "The State is the executive committee of the bourgeoisie." Who said it? Who wrote *The Origin of the Family, Private Property and the State*?

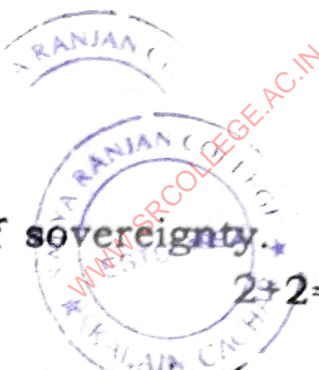
